Spring Term Clubs

We have been looking at clubs and want to offer some different clubs for the children to participate in. There will be some more clubs in the summer term but we hope you like the variety that is on offer this term. Can I say thank you to staff for giving up their time to take these clubs and for offering a really diverse set of the activities/clubs for the children to participate in. Can I also ask that children attending clubs are genuinely interested in the club on offer. The clubs are not supposed to be an alternative to child care but rather an opportunity for children to try something new.

Premier Sports will still offer after school sports clubs which will continue to be subsidised by school.

All clubs will start straight after classes finish at 3pm and will finish at the times stated below. Children should be collected from the playground. **Please note that the majority of the clubs start after half term so please check their start date.**

As some of the clubs require materials and resources there will be a small charge. If there is a charge for a club this is shown on the list below. When applying for a place in clubs with a cost please send the money in with the slip. If your child does not get a place we will send the money home.

Please note that there are limited places for each club but, whilst we will try to accommodate as many pupils as possible, if any clubs are oversubscribed names will be drawn from a hat to allocate places. If a child does not get a place on a club this term we will keep a log of their names and ensure they are prioritised for a space on a club in the summer term. If your child is interested in attending any of the clubs listed below please complete (by ticking the appropriate box) **and return the slip to school by Wednesday 17th January at the latest.** We will inform parents by school ping if your child has been allocated a place in a club. If you are not yet accessing school ping please contact the office for your login details.
